



5 Easy Steps

to clean your Pokémon cards



1

PRACTISE FIRST

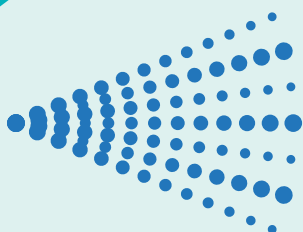
Start on a cheap or damaged card to get used to the cleaner.

💪 Build your confidence.

2

INSPECT THE CARD

Inspect the card under bright light. Take a before photo for reference and confirm it's not a print defect.



3

APPLY CLEANER

Spray 2 pumps onto a cotton swab - never directly on the card.

💧 Don't soak the swab — just dampen it.

4

GENTLY CLEAN

Rub in light, directional motions, focusing on dirty areas only. For stubborn spots, reapply cleaner or use the Rejuvit pick.

✨ Avoid edges, corners, and cracks.



5

WIPE DRY

Wipe the card with a clean microfiber cloth and ensure it's completely dry. If edges are wet, allow the card to air dry completely.



5 Easy Steps

to clean vintage Pokémon cards

INSPECT THE CARD

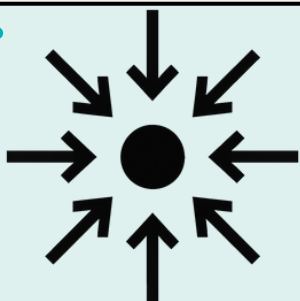
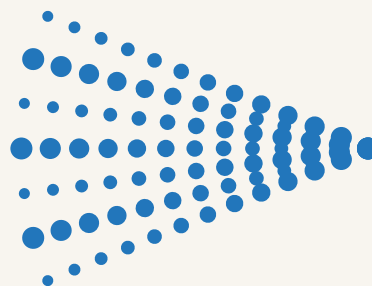
Inspect the card under bright light. Take a before photo for reference and confirm it's not a print defect.

2

APPLY CLEANER

Spray 2 pumps onto a cotton swab - never directly on the card. Don't soak the swab - just dampen it.

👉 Use the pointed tip to minimise surface contact.



3

GENTLY CLEAN

Tap the spot lightly to loosen grime. Follow with 1mm soft micro-drags, pulling toward the centre. For stubborn spots, use the Rejuvit pick.

🌀 Work from multiple angles — not wide strokes.

4

WATCH TIP

Dirt should appear dark grey or black.

If the swab begins to unravel, pinch it back or switch to a new one.

💡 Reduce pressure immediately if you see colour.



5

WIPE DRY

Wipe the card with a clean microfibre cloth and make sure it is fully dry before sleeving.



5 Easy Steps

to polish your Pokémon cards

PRACTISE FIRST

Start on a cheap or damaged card to get used to the polish.

💡 Build your confidence.

2

PICK THE RIGHT CARD

For holo cards only. Do not use on non - holo cards.



3

USE A CLEAN FOAM SWAB

Apply a small amount of polish to a clean, fresh swab. After use, wash the swab thoroughly for future applications.

🧽 Fresh swab. Small amount. Big results.



4

APPLY IN CIRCULAR MOTIONS

Use gentle, circular pressure. Focus on the holo surface - avoid corners, cracks, and edges.



5

BUFF AND REPEAT

Gently buff with a clean cloth, checking for residue or streaks. For optimal results, reapply and buff up to 3 times if needed.



5 Easy Steps

to polish your cards for grading



1

USE A CLEAN FOAM SWAB

Apply a small amount of polish to a clean, fresh swab. After use, wash the swab thoroughly for future applications.

🧽 Fresh swab. Small amount. Big results.

2

APPLY IN CIRCULAR MOTIONS

Use gentle, circular pressure, focusing on the holographic surface. Avoid corners, cracks, and edges. Apply only once.



3

BUFF CAREFULLY

Gently buff with a clean cloth, checking for residue or streaks.

4

CLEAN GENTLY

Apply card cleaner to a cotton swab and gently wipe the area where card polish was applied.



5

INSPECT CAREFULLY

Check the corners, edges and surface for any remaining residue. Use a bright light to inspect carefully and let sit for 1 hour before sleeving.
